A MILESTONE FOR DRAFT THE HILLS LEP 2010

Draft The Hills Local Environmental Plan (LEP) 2010 has been given the go-ahead by the NSW Department of Planning to be placed on public exhibition.

Council's Group Manager - Strategic Planning, Michael Edgar said "this achievement is a milestone in the planning process and Council is determined to make the plan available to the community as soon as possible."

"Council is committed to deliver a thorough community consultation process and ensure residents have the opportunity to be involved, learn and get to know the Draft Local Environmental Plan 2010" he said. "It is important to understand Draft LEP 2010 reflects a format set by the NSW Government to standardise local

environmental plans across the state. Therefore the Draft LEP is different to Council's current Baulkham Hills Local Environmental Plan 2005" Mr Edgar said. Whilst zone names have changed, for some properties the new zoning will be very similar to the current zoning and the land uses that can be carried out on that property will not change. For other properties the new zoning will change how the land can be used.

The public exhibition will include material to help the community understand the new aspects of the plan including a dedicated website providing access to all exhibition material and the opportunity to participate in an online forum. An interactive map application is also available online to allow residents to search their property

and help understand how the plan applies to their property. Copies of the draft LEP will go on display at Council's Administration Centre and all Council libraries. There is also a dedicated telephone information line 02 9843 0206 and of course our town planning staff will be available to answer questions about the draft LEP.

It is anticipated the public exhibition will commence on Tuesday 29 March 2011 and close on Friday 13 May 2011. All property owners will be individually notified when the plan goes on exhibition with information on how they can be involved as well as coverage in the local newspapers and Council's website.

IMPORTANT PUBLIC NOTICE

Sydney-North Regional Fox Baiting Program

Please be advised that the regional fox baiting program will be undertaken at local reserves in the Sydney North Region. The aim of the project is to protect native wildlife including threatened species from fox predation. 1080 poison baits will be laid in the following Reserves:

Excelsior Reserve

Managed by The Hills Shire Council

Bidjigal Reserve

Managed by The Bidjigal Reserve Trust

Foxoff® poison baits (containing 1080) will be laid from Saturday 12 March–Sunday 27 March 2011

The fox control program will involve the use of 'Foxoff® Econobait' poison baits that are designed specifically for fox control. Poison baits contain 1080 (sodium monofluoroacetate). Baits will be buried to reduce the risk of non-target poisoning. Warning signs will be displayed to notify the public about the program. It is vital that pet owners take extra precautions to ensure that their pets do not enter these reserves during the dates stated. Penalties up to \$1,100 apply under the *Local Government Act (1993) Sect 632 (2) (d)*.

WARNING

1080 poison is lethal to dogs and cats.

**Dogs must not enter baited reserves during the following dates
Saturday 12 March–Sunday 24 April 2011**

Dogs on leads can return to these reserves on Monday 25 April 2011.
