FACS Housing Services Link2home Ph: 1800 152 152	You can speak to someone 24 hours a day, 7 days a week. They can give information or refer you to a service that can best help you resolve your homelessness issue.
Marist 180 (Homelessness Services) Ph: 9672 9200	Homeless or at risk of being homeless, short to medium term accommodation for young people.
Ask Izzy - A to Z Directory of Homeless Help Information Askizzy.org.au	Ask Izzy helps people who are homeless or at risk of becoming homeless to find the services they need, right now and nearby. Can help find housing, meals, health services, counselling, legal help, addiction help and other services.
San Miguel Family Centre – yourtown Ph: 4579 6622	Short term and transitional accommodation for families experiencing homelessness. Operates in North Richmond area.
Red Cross - Blacktown Office Ph: 9229 4272	Providing national certification in first aid to people with low literacy, limited income or poor experiences with the education system, targeting people who have experienced homelessness.
Mission Australia 1800 384 331	Western Sydney Homelessness Outreach Prevention and Rapid Rehousing Service supports people over the age of 21 years and families who are homeless or at risk of homelessness. Clients aged 21 years or older who are at risk of, or experiencing homelessness within the Parramatta (including the new Cumberland district), Blacktown LGA's and the Hills District.
