

Roxborough Park Rose Garden changes

The construction of the new Waves Aquatic Centre will have a minor impact on the Roxborough Park Rose Garden, however Council is committed to retaining and improving the garden.

- As part of the aquatic centre upgrade, Council needs to manage the overland flow of water in the Roxborough Park site as an identified floodway sits within it.
- Council has worked hard to minimise the impact to the rose garden where it borders the aquatic centre, however a small section will be impacted. This area will be reprofiled, resulting in the removal of the existing garden beds along the pool boundary edge.
- Some garden beds at the north-east end of the site are impacted and varieties of these roses will be transplanted within the garden.
- A small section of the lawn area is also impacted, however the pine trees and the remainder of the grassed area will remain.
- The walking paths within the garden will remain open and any impacted paths will be modified to link to existing paths.



Rose Garden Improvements

Council is committed to maintaining and improving the Roxborough Park Rose Garden. Funds have been allocated to enhance the garden with planned works to include:

- upgrading the rotunda
- improving the stairs
- updating the irrigation system
- creating new garden edging

These, along with a range of general garden improvements, will ensure the rose garden is available for community enjoyment into the future.
