No. 4. — 10 per cent. deposit, balance in 24 quarterly payments, interest 6 per cent.

No. 5. — 10 per cent. deposit, balance in 32 quarterly payments, interest 7 per cent.

No. 6. — 10 per cent. deposit, balance on Building Society's terms, viz.: at the rate of 5s. a month for each £25 owing

EXAMPLE OF TERMS

Supposing a person purchased £60 worth of Land on Terms—

- No. 1. he would pay £15 cash, and the balance, less discount, £45 in 7 days.
- No. 2. 60 cash and a quarterly payment of 10 lbs.
- No. 3. 60 cash, and 10 lbs. in the first quarter, decreasing every quarter.
- No. 4. 60 cash and 10 lbs. in the first quarter, decreasing every quarter.
- No. 5. 60 cash, and 10 lbs. in the first quarter, decreasing every quarter.
- No. 6. 60 cash, and 10 lbs. in the first quarter, decreasing every quarter.
